2019 NAPLAN Testing Schedule

Dear Parents/Caregivers

As previously notified, the College will conduct all NAPLAN tests (except the Year 3 Writing Test) online this year. The College trialed online tests last year and our experience was that students were not only comfortable with the online format, but more engaged in the NAPLAN tasks.

The NAPLAN Online Test Period is scheduled to run from Tuesday 14 May until Friday 24 May. The planned schedule for the Victor Harbor Campus is outlined below:

Catch-up tests for absent students may be held during designated catch-up sessions, or students may be asked to join any scheduled test session to complete tests they have missed.
