The Reception students from both campuses will visit the Currency Creek EcoCentre on Thursday 16, 23 and 30 May as part of their Biological Sciences unit "Staying Alive". Students will engage in a range of activities about the different types of living things found at the site and the things they require to stay alive.

There will be a specific focus on the different bird species found at the Currency Creek EcoCentre. We will explore the habitats birds live in, what they eat, and how they build their nests. Students will also look at ways we can attract birds into our own backyards at home by providing some of the things they need.

During the excursions students will also be involved in nature play activities, like cubby house construction and creating artwork as we spend time outside exploring the natural environment.

Students will travel to Currency Creek by bus departing the Victor Harbor Campus at 8:50am and the Goolwa Campus at 9:20am. Students will return to the Goolwa Campus at 2:50pm and the Victor Harbor Campus at 3:10pm.
