Dear Parents/Caregivers of current Year 10 students

As the academic year enters its final phase, students and staff are beginning to direct their thoughts to the completion of Year 10 and commencement of Year 11 in 2021. With this in mind, the College seeks to support students through the final assessments in Year 10 and commence their Year 11 requirements prior to the end of the current year.

Year 10 exams officially commence on Monday 25 November and continue through to Wednesday 27 November. Exams have been scheduled during class time and normal class attendance is expected throughout the period, up to and including Friday 29 November.

In order to better prepare students for a successful Year 11, a **Head Start Transition Program** will take place in the Senior School building on Monday 30 November – Tuesday 1 December. **Attendance is compulsory as a vital component of the Year 10 curriculum.** Students are required to wear College Formal or Summer uniform.

Please note that Year 10 students are **not** required at school after Tuesday 1 December.

The Head Start Transition Program will provide students with an opportunity to receive important information regarding their subjects, SACE requirements and policies, and College expectations. The main focus of the day will be the requirements of selected SACE subjects including the Research Project (a compulsory, independent study required of all SACE students) as well as SACE and College policies and study skills. Students should come prepared with a display folder and their pencil case.

The Head Start Transition Program is an important first step in students' preparation for a rewarding and successful Year 11 and means that students can commence 2021 with a clear understanding of expectations, potential difficulties and subject requirements.

The Program is **compulsory** for all students intending to undertake Year 11 at Investigator College in 2021. It concludes the official academic year of Investigator College Year 10 students.

The exam timetable is attached. We look forward to seeing all students and take this opportunity to wish all Year 10 students every success in their final examinations and assessments.
