Dear Parents/Caregivers of Reception students,

As we prepare to welcome your child/ren back to Investigator College, it is important that we do it in a COVID safe manner. For the safety of our community there are a range of measures being put in place to minimise the spread of COVID. We ask parents/caregivers to QR sign in, socially distance, hand sanitise and wear a mask while on school grounds.

From Day 1, **Wednesday 2 February, we ask that you drop your child off at the classroom door and do not enter the classroom with your child.** To help your child transition to school we will have a number of activities set up outside the classroom and some opportunities for photos. This will help to make the first day of school special and memorable for your child. Please be assured we also have allocated Educational Support Officers (ESOs) to assist any children who may be nervous about their first day in Reception.

At the end of the school day you can meet your child outside the classroom. The Reception teachers will walk the students over to the buses and the kiss and drop area if previously arranged.

The "in-school grounds" drop off and collection advice (above) are the guidelines to follow, up until and including Week 2. Further information with regards to Week 3 onwards, will be sent out at a later date.
